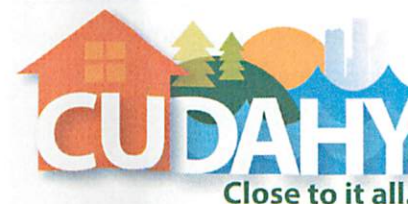

Catch the wave — we will waive all Cudahy overdue fines! One day only. Cardholder must be present.

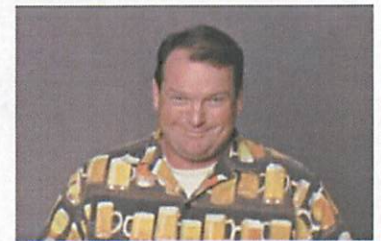
